MANDATORY PLAYER ASSESSMENTS

Why are Assessments Required?

We take great pride in continuing the *Interleague Edmonton Little League* tradition of having balanced regular season teams. Remember, these assessments are *not intended to be a competition!*

As outlined in the *Little League Rule Book*, mandatory pre-season assessments are done so that all leagues have the best chance at creating balanced teams for A and AA divisions.

We recognize that most players may not have touched a baseball in months. Please inform your player(s) that assessments are not competitive and that there should be no pressure or stress associated with them. Every player will be placed on a balanced team with a supportive coach.

- There are 6 assessment sessions available for Major and Minor players,
- There are 2 assessment sessions available for Junior and Senior players,
- All sessions are 1 hour and 30 minutes in duration, and
- Space in each session is limited, so sign up early.

Who Needs to Attend?

- Any Rookie player (age 8) who would like to consider playing up in the Minor division,
- All Minor players (age 9 and 10),
- All Major players (age 11 and 12),
- All Junior players (age 13 and 14), and
- All **Senior** players (age 15 and 16)

Assessment Process

All assessments are conducted by the Trappers coaching staff, with support from league coaches and directors. All players attending must be signed up in advance, and in the correct division. We are unable to accommodate assessments of siblings in different divisions in the same session – players must attend in their own assessment time. Family members, and other spectators are welcome to watch from the sidelines.

Please Wear:

- Indoor running shoes (no cleats),
- Baseball or athletic pants, or shorts,
- · Comfortable shirt allowing full range of motion, and
- Jackets and outdoor shoes must be left outside of the playing.

Please Bring:

- Baseball glove,
- Batting helmet, and
- Regulation baseball bat.

Please note we are not able to provide players with gloves or helmets, and sharing of personal equipment is not permitted. Any player who does not have their own glove and helmet will be required to sign up for a time when they do have their own equipment.

Player Can't Make Assessment?

While we strive to provide a variety of dates and times, we realize that some players may not be able to attend an assessment time. If this happens, the player will:

- Not be eligible for the AA division, and
- Not be eligible to play up a division.
